STAGE ADVENTURE RACE

The Amazons Australia is a stage adventure race, which will give teams up to 8 hours to navigate their way each day through the course searching for checkpoints whilst trekking, mountain biking and kayaking. There may be multiple legs of each discipline on each day. Navigational skills are certainly going to help teams travel through the course more efficiently, but you have plenty of time to work on this.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Early entries are opening on 30 November 2025 and as there are only 50 team spots available, we are encouraging you to enter early, to avoid missing out. Entries will be online via Event Plus and the link will be found on page on The <u>Amazons Australia</u> website. The link will be able to be viewed before entries open, but you will not be able to enter details until Sunday 30 November 2026.







Entry Cost Per Team of Two

Early Entry \$975 per person or \$1950 per Team (30 November 2025 - midnight 31 December 2025)

Standard Entry \$1075 per person or \$2150 per team (1 January 2026 - until midnight 31 March 2026)

Late Entry \$1175 per person or \$2350 per team (accepted after 1 April 2026 if not sold out until midnight Sunday 7 June 2026)

CATEGORIES

Adventure Racing traditionally has teams of Mixed, Male and female teams and not much differentiation for different age categories, so for The Amazons Australia we have three categories based on age* 1 July 2026.

Legends - Two women over 50* who are willing to show the younger generations just what fearless means.

Warriors - Two women over 30* who are strong, skilled and up for any type of adventure.

Princesses - Two women under 30* who are tough and resilient, so ready to step up for the adventure.

Tribes - Two women - mothers, daughters, sisters or friends who's ages do not fit the other categories, who are fearless yet friendly and keen for the adventure.

ACCOMMODATION

The event HQ is located right in the heart of the town of Mission Beach, sometimes referred to as North Mission Beach. There are plenty of places to suit all budgets that are within walking distance to HQ.

We strongly advise that you try to stay nice and close to the event HQ as that will be where we gather each day for the event briefing and also where you will end up after finishing.

TRANSPORT

We recommend that participants flying to the event, fly into Cairns as there are shuttles that service the Mission Beach area. Qantas, Jetstar and Virgin provide daily flights directly into Cairns Domestic International Airports. Air New Zealand and Singapore Airlines service the International Airport.

Airports Cairns Domestic and International Airport – 2hrs North of Mission Beach

Townsville Domestic Airport - 3 hours South of Mission Beach

Shuttles

The local shuttle service to Mission Beach is Mission Link. It takes approximately 3 hours. If booking this service, please ensure that you advise the transport company that you are travelling with a bike. Below is the link to their website.

We are hoping to provide an event shuttle* from Cairns Airport. This would transport you and your gear directly from the domestic / international airport to Mission Beach - HQ. At this stage, to take advantage of this service, you will need to plan to arrive before 1pm on Saturday 4 July 2026. It is proposed that the event shuttle will depart the Airport at approximately 2pm

Following the event, the shuttle will depart Mission Beach - HQ at approximately 8am on Friday 10 July 2026 and should have you at the airport by approximately 11am (*Subject to change depending on service provider and there being sufficient bookings).

Cost \$120 Per Person (return) or \$65 per person (one way)

HOW DO YOU BECOME AN AMAZON?

Well, that's easy, read these Q& As, find a partner who is willing to take on the challenge, enter the event and before long you will be on the start line and making history!

How fit do I have to be for The Amazons Australia?

The Amazons Australia is a stage race, this means that you will only be out on the course for up to 8 hours each day. There are 3 main disciplines – kayaking, trekking and mountain biking – so realistically you would need to be able to spend around 3 hours on each discipline. You can stop and take a break whenever you like, and you get a chance to swap from one discipline to another many times throughout each day of the event.

What is a Transition Area?

A transition area or TA is a place/location where you may change from one discipline to another. In The Amazons Adventure Race, you will be required to pack gear into bags and officials will transport bags, bikes, kayaks to the TAs for you. The logistics planner and the course notes will provide information such as discipline & approx. time/ distance so you can pack what you need before the start of each day. For safety reasons you are always required to check in at all the TAs marked on the course







How technical will the course be? Do I need to be an expert in every discipline?

Kayaking – the kayaks provided for the event are very stable and buoyant and relatively easy to paddle. You are required to have some ability to steer these as the kayaks have no foot steering pedals. The paddling for the Amazons Australia will be in both white-water environments and protected open ocean environments. For the white-water sections, you will paddle inflatable double kayaks (provided by the organisers) and there will we water guides on the course for safety. Ocean kayaking will be in protected waters, meaning there will not be surf, but the wind and tides can have an impact on how choppy the water is. So, we recommend that you and your partner practise together so you can handle a range of conditions and steer a kayak confidently.

Mountain Biking – You can expect to ride your mountain bike on roads, paths, dirt roads, sand and mountain bike trails in the event. So, some experience in riding mountain bike trails would be highly desirable, however in adventure racing it is totally fine to get off and walk whenever the conditions are above your skill level or simply too steep to ride up or down.

Trekking – If you have ever done a trail run before you will be fine. The tracks and trails for The Amazons Australia will vary, there will be some hills for sure, as well as plenty of rough, uneven ground. Be prepared to get your feet wet and be comfortable running with wet feet as well. We recommend that you have specific trail running shoes for the event.

WHY THE AMAZONS AUSTRALIA?

Jan and Kim from Tri Adventure have been involved in the sport of Adventure Racing now for more than 20 years each and collectively have over 100 years of experience in endurance sports. Over 12 years ago we created the Wild Women Adventure Race, which was the first all-female adventure race in Australia and this event is definitely a highlight of the AR calendar in Australia every year.

In 2024 we set up a meeting with the CEO of the ARWS and proposed the concept of The Amazons Australia, an all-female 3 day stage event. In July 2025, we successfully delivered the very first ARWS all female event and we continue to provide a platform for women to aspire to be Amazons – women who are independent, fearless and ready to be challenged – for without an opportunity to see what we, as women are truly capable of achieving, we as women may not live our lives to the fullest!
